Do you bake or cook with honey? This is your chance to show off your cooking skills!

Entries will only be accepted from 8:00 AM until 9:00 AM on the day of the event.

- All are welcome to enter the Cooking Show
- A person shall not offer for exhibit any item not produced and/or prepared by the owner
- An Exhibitor will make only one entry in Cooking
- Placings will be awarded on basis of quality of exhibit—the decision of the judge(s) will be final
- No labels or identification on any entry until judged
- Entries will be displayed prior to serving as the coffee break or luncheon desert. Please bring entire batch and/or entry.
- Return of Dishes and containers is the responsibility of the exhibitor and must be removed post meeting or will be disposed of accordingly. Mass Bee cannot be responsible for lost dishes.

COOKING

Your Favorite “Sweet Treat” made with honey

- All entries must include a recipe on 8 ½” x 11” paper (measurements in cups and ounces)
- Recipes must include ingredients, as well as directions for mixing, cooking, baking etc.
- All entries must contain 25% honey as sweetening ingredient agent. Example: Use ¾ cup of sugar and ¼ cup of honey. Pie crusts and frostings are exempt from the 25% rule
- No labels or markings of any kind allowed on entries
- Entries will be judged on appearance, taste and texture.
